




美國教會會友人數首次降至多數以下 U.S. CHURCH MEMBERSHIP FALLS BELOW MAJORITY FOR FIRST TIME





B. 復興家庭 REVIVE OUR FAMILY


從節目導向到家庭導向 FROM PROGRAM-ORIENTED TO FAMILY-ORIENTED

影響年輕人生活的前五位是:

The top five influences in the life of young people are:

- (1) 父母 Parents
- (2) 其他家庭成員,通常是祖父母.
 Other family members, typically grandparents
- (3) 老師和教練 Teachers and coaches
- (4) 朋友 Friends
- (5) 牧師或宗教領袖 Pastors or religious leaders

如果教會想從影響年輕人的信仰,最大的投資回報策略將來自於裝備父母和祖父母在自己的家中成為門徒製造者disciple-maker。
If churches want to impact the faith of young people, strategically, the greatest return on investment will come from equipping parents and grandparents to be disciple-makers within their own families.



CHRISTIANITY IS CAUGHT MORE THAN IT'S TAUGHT

即將到來的一代面臨信仰的障礙,是超越崇拜的方式,教導的實用性,或教會節目的精益求精,因為它不在於在教堂發生的事情,而在於在家裡沒有發生的事情.

The upcoming generation confronts an obstacle to belief that goes beyond worship style, teaching relevance, or church-program excellence, because it in not about what's happening at church. It's about what's missing at home.



青年人能夠持守青少年時的信仰的首要原因 THE NO. 1 REASON TEENS KEEP THE FAITH AS YOUNG ADULTS

父母對信仰的重視

The National Study of Youth and Religion

在對宗教幾乎不重視的父母所撫養的15至17歲的青少年中, 只有1%的人在25至30歲時依然保持著高度的宗教信仰。

Just 1% of teens ages 15 to 17 raised by parents who attached little importance to religion were highly religious in their mid-to-late 20s.

相反,在經常在家中講論信仰、重視他們的信仰,並且活躍 於教會的父母所撫養的青少年中,有高達82%的人在成為青 年後依然在宗教信仰方面十分活躍。

In contrast, 82% of children raised by parents who talked about faith at home, attached great importance to their beliefs and were active in their congregations were themselves religiously active as young adults.

父親的屬靈影響力 A FATHER'S SPIRITUAL INFLUENCE

- 當家庭中首先接觸教會的是家中的青少年時,全家都追隨的概率只有3.5% When a teenager is the first to connect to a church, 3.5% of the time the family follows.
- 當家庭中首先接觸教會的是家中的妻子/母親時,這個機率提升至<mark>22%</mark> When a women is the first to connect to a church, 22% of the time the family follows.
- 但當家庭中首先接觸教會的是家中的丈夫/父親時,這個機率高達<mark>93%</mark> But when a man (husband/father) is the first to connect to a church, 93% of the time the family follows.

- 哈佛大學學生報紙對應屆畢業生的一項調查發現,只有6.4%的受訪者在 進入私立常春藤盟校後傾向於保守。
- 它還調查了學生在上哈佛之前的政治狀況,發現7.1%的畢業生在上大學 之前被認為是保守派。
- A <u>Harvard University</u> student newspaper survey of graduating students found that only 6.4% of the people who responded were conservative-leaning after attending the private Ivy League institution.
- It also surveyed the students about what their politics were before attending Harvard and found that 7.1% of the graduating class identified as conservative before attending the college.



賀拉斯·曼-美國公立學校之父 (1796 – 1859) HORACE MANN – THE FATHER OF PUBLIC EDUCATION

正如教會是給中世紀的人,公立學校必須成為給民主和理性的人。 上帝將被公共利益的概念所取代。 What the church has been for medieval man the public school must become for democratic and rational man. God will be replaced by the concept of the public good.



他想建立"一種以國家為真正教會的新宗教,並以教育為其彌賽亞進行."(老師為祭司) He wanted to establish "a new religion, with state as its true church, and education its Messiah." (teacher as priest) 在1930年代,深具影響力的教育家喬治·康茲(George S. Counts)明確呼籲教師開始"控制社會的演化"。他激勵他們"救贖"社會,不再僅僅是文化的傳遞者,還要成為"社會價值的創造者"。教育工作者應刻意爭取權力,以"建立新社會秩序",喚醒學生對"社會問題"的意識,並鼓勵他們提出管理社會的其他方法。今天,許多學校正在這樣做...而且興高采烈。

布蘭代斯大學的弗雷德里克·索默斯(Frederic Sommers)說,大多數教育者不再將教育定義為促進對真理的追求和傳承有價值的遺產。相反,他們將教育定義為"通過警告學生對抗父權制種族主義和階級主義的鬥爭來賦予學生權力的一種手段"。
