#### Now We Have a Dilemma 我們現在陷入困境

It seems that all of a sudden the music stopped. The coronavirus hit one country after another. Our health and lives are suddenly at risk.

We wake up to the reality we are unprepared for a disaster like coronavirus - we don't have enough face mask, protective gears, ventilator, hospital bed & medicines. Even hand sanitizers and rubbing alcohol have run out. As people stop eating out and stay home, the coronavirus set off a chain reaction causing businesses to plummet from one business sector to another. fall down like dominos.

Businesses are falling down like dominos

Now the government is telling us it needs to create trillions of \$ (from nothing) to rescue the economy, without which unemployment could hit 30%

#### Who Brought the Coronavirus In?

- 1. Human by mistake
  - a) from eating wild animals like bats
  - b) from handling error in a virus research lab
- 2. Satan on purpose, just like he attacked Job
- 3. God for a purpose
  - a) Judgment on people's or the leaders' sins. Ex. 9:3; Num 14::37; 16:46; 25:9; 2 Sam 24:15
  - b) Warning sign of His coming: Luke 21:11; Rev. 6:8;

#### We have been warned 神早已給我們警告

The Bible tells us "When people say, "There is peace and security," then sudden destruction will come upon them as labor pains come upon a pregnant woman, and there will be no escape." 1 Thessalonians 5:3 人正說平安穩妥的時候、災禍忽然臨到他們、如同產難臨到懷胎的婦人一樣,他們絕不能逃脫。(帖前5:3)



Earthquakes, volcanoes, severe weather, wildfires, drought, diseases, terrorist acts, mass shootings, financial crisis and wars all have one thing in common: they all increase in numbers, intensity and frequency. We see these happening now and will continue to happen before the return of Christ. The Bible refers to them as "birth pangs"

#### We have been warned 神早已給我們警告

God has given us plenty of warnings in the Bible and numerous signs that we are living in the end time before Christ's return. If we are not aware of His coming, we are either blind, ignorant or not taking God's word seriously.

There will be very difficult time ahead of Jesus' return. "For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been from the beginning of the world until now, no, and never will be." (Mat 24:21) 因為那時、必有大災難、從世界的起頭、直到如今、沒有這樣的災難、後來也必沒有。(太 24:21)

# Won't Christians be Raptured Before the Great Tribulations? 基督徒不是會在災前被提嗎?

There are different views about the timing of the rapture

- 1. Pre-tribulation rapture (災前被提)
- 2. Mid-tribulation rapture (災中被提)
- 3. Post-tribulation rapture (災後被提)
- 4. Partial pre-tribulation rapture (部份災前被提)

If we have to go thru some sort of tribulation, how shall we face it? 我們若要經歷災難當怎麼面對它

The Book of Habakkuk is the right book for end-time Christians to read because it was written for a nation facing enemy invasion and devastation.

#### Background of Habakkuk 哈巴谷的背景

Hubakkuk prophesied during the reigns of the last 2 kings of Judah before the nation was destroyed by the Babylonians

The book of Hubakkuk is different from other prophetic books in that it does not have a message for the people. It is the prophet's personal dialogue with God



This drawing of Hubakkuk picture him scratching his head trying to understand God. He was perplexed.

Twice Hubakkuk brought his questions to God and

demanded God to answer him. God did answer him, though not the answers Habakkuk was hoping for.

Habakkuk's name means "embracer 擁抱者".
He embraced God when he had questions & doubts. He embraced God as he faced calamity coming to his nation.



Habakkuk believed that God is righteous, but he confronted God why He allowed violence, injustice, & neglect of the law in the society. After complaining for 20 years, God's answer suddenly came. He told Habakkuk He had been raising up the Babylonians to judge His people for their sins.

Habakkuk could not believe what God said. The Babylonians were the most dreadful, cruel and violent people. They would utterly destroy the whole nation & wipe out God's people. How could God use these most wicked Babylonians to judge the less wicked Jews who is God's chosen people?





So Habakkuk protested to God about His plan to use the Babylonians. He stationed himself in a tower on the city wall and waited for God to explain Himself.

"I will stand at my watch and station myself on the ramparts; I will look to see what He will say to me, and what answer I am to give to this complaint." (2:1)

The reply God gave to Habakkuk was a revelation and is the key message of the book. He told Habakkuk:

"Behold, he whose soul is not upright in him (Babylonians) shall fail, but the righteous shall live by faith" Hab. 2:4 迦勒底人自高自大、心不正直、惟義人因信得生。(谷2:4)

#### The Righteous Shall Live by Faith (義人必因信得生)

The interpretation is: the righteous shall survive because he put his trust in the Lord 義人必憑信得存活



This is the key, the survival guide for a time of calamity. God instructed Habakkuk to proclaim this message: "Write down the revelation and make it plain on tablets so that a herald may run with it."

#### The Righteous Shall Live by Faith (義人必因信得生)

This is the key verse in the Book of Habakkuk. It is also a key concept throughout the Bible:

Abram believed the LORD, and He credited it to him as righteousness. 亞伯蘭信耶和華、耶和華就以此為他的義(Genesis 創 15:6)

This important verse is quoted 3 times in the New Testament with different emphasis. 這重要經節在新約也被引用三次

1) For in the gospel a righteousness from God is revealed, a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: "The righteous will live by faith." Rom 1:17
The emphasis here is righteousness – a righteousness imputed on the believer based on faith in Jesus Christ. 因為神的義、正在這福音上顯明出來,這義是本於信、以致於信,如經上所記、『義人必因信得生。』(羅 1:15) 這裏的着重點是義.信耶穌基督得着從神而來給予的義。

#### The Righteous Shall Live by Faith (義人必因信得生)

2) Clearly no one is justified before God by the law, because, "The righteous will live by faith." Galatians 3:11 The emphasis here is faith – justification based on faith in Jesus Christ, not by observing the law. 沒有一個人靠著律法在神面前稱義、這是明顯的,因為經

3) "You need to persevere so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what He has promised. For in just a very little while, "He who is coming will come and will not delay. But my righteous one will live by faith" Heb. 10:36-38 The emphasis here is live (out your faith amid trials). This is also the emphasis in Habakkuk. "你們必須忍耐、使你們行完了神的旨意、就可以得著所應許的。『因為還有一點點時候、那要來的就來、並不遲延。只是義人必因信得生"(來 10:36-38) 這裏的着重點是生(活)(在災難試鍊時活出真信心來)這也是哈巴谷書所着重的。

#### How Can We Have Faith (如何獲取信心)

Biblical faith is not blind faith. It is grounded on God's words which are facts. God said it and it shall be done.

"So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by (from) the word of God (Rehema – God's spoken words, not written words)" (Rom 10:17) 可見信心是由于聽到道,所聽的道是藉著基督的話 (Rehema -說出來的話,不是寫下來的話)。(新譯本+呂振中譯本混合) 羅馬書 10:17


All heroes of faith derived their faith after God spoke to them. Noah, Abraham, Moses, Elijah, Peter, Paul....etc.

God spoke to Habakkuk, therefore Habakkuk was able to have the faith to face the coming calamity. God also commanded Habakkuk to proclaim to the people "the just shall live by faith". Therefore those who heard it and received it can also have the faith to face calamity.

#### Faith & Fear 信心與懼怕

#### When Faith Begins, Fear Ends 信心的開始就是懼怕的結束

Men of great faith had times of fear



Abraham was in fear when the Lord said to him: "Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield, your very great reward." 耶和華對亞伯蘭說: 你不要懼怕、我是你的盾牌、必大大的賞賜你。 (Genesis 創世記 15)

#### When Fear Begins, Faith Ends 懼怕的開始就是信心的結束

Prophet Elijah singled handedly defeated 450 prophets of Baal and slaughtered them on Mount Carmel, yet when queen Jezebel wanted to kill him, Elijah was afraid and ran for his life. (1 Kings 18: 22, 39-40; 19:1-4)

#### Sometimes Circumstances Can Get Very Scary



"Lord, if it's you," Peter replied, "tell me to come to you on the water.""Come," He said. Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came toward Jesus.

But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, "Lord, save me!"(Mat. 14:28-31)



#### FAITH IN SPITE OF CIRCUMSTANCES 超越環境的信心



Against all hope, Abraham in hope believed. Without weakening in his faith, he faced the fact that his body was as good as dead--since he was about a hundred years old--and that Sarah's womb was also dead. Yet he did not waver through unbelief regarding the promise of God, being fully persuaded that God had power to do what He had promised. (Romans 4)

Though the fig tree does not bud and there are no grapes on the vines, though the olive crop fails and the fields produce no food, though there are no sheep in the pen and no cattle in the stalls, yet I will rejoice in the LORD, I will be joyful in God my Savior. (Habakkuk 3: 17,18)


"Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?
